

At TIPS Kindercare we follow the Cambridge Early Years program for 3-6 yrs. It gives young learners the best start in life, helping them to meet key early milestones and thrive in and outside of school. Cambridge Early Years is the first stage in our Cambridge Pathway, which gives students a clear path for educational success from age 3-19.

THE CAMBRIDGE EARLY YEARS CURRICULUM:

- follows a holistic approach that focuses on the whole child and connects their development with the world and people around them.
- is built around four key areas of early childhood development:



- develops knowledge, understanding and skills through a spiral approach, by revisiting and engaging with topics and skills in more depth at each stage.
- helps learners to meet internationally established milestones for early development. Although children develop at different rates, the curriculum provides a structure for teaching and learning that will help you to monitor and support each child's progress.
- supports a bilingual or multilingual approach for learners with a home language other than English, as well as those with different experiences of English
- prepares learners to easily transition into Cambridge Primary, or the next stage in their education.
- content is split into six curriculum areas to guide you and support progress.

WHY CHOOSE CAMBRIDGE EARLY YEARS?



It helps children develop the knowledge, understanding and skills they need for the next stage in their education whether they move on to Cambridge Primary or another programme.



It is a child-centred, play-based programme that helps young learners to develop at their own pace. It encourages them to act independently, make their own choices and discover feelings of self-worth.

Toddler

Age: 1.5 to 2.5 years

For many, Toddler Class is the first-time children spend time away from their parents. Our warm, caring environment helps students to take this step without additional stress being placed upon the child. Our Toddler Program is developed for students of 1.5 to 2.5 years age. Birth through the age of three is the most critical learning years for children. Our staff is trained to provide your child with emotional and social support to enhance your child's development. Our program will foster a strong foundation for learning, growing, and developing. In addition, we offer stimulating and friendly environment supplied with hands-on materials that will help our Toddlers gain control of their large and small motor skills.



Early Years 1 (EY1)

Age: 2.5 to 3.5 years

Early Years 1 at TIPS starts with acclimatising and familiarizing children with their new daily environment at school. After children settle in, which usually takes up to 3 weeks, they are introduced to EPL (Exercise of practical life) and sensorial materials. Apart from that, children also spend time with open-ended materials which include materials from nature and also blocks. Nature walks on campus and collection of materials from nature is part of the regular curriculum. Rhyme time involves finger rhymes and also regular kindergarten themed songs. During circle time there is a lot of focus on children moving around in animal movements, creeping, crawling, balance walk, bean bags, balancing using bean bags as well as opportunities to express themselves, and a lot of listening through stories and object talk. Even storytelling in this grade is much subtler than in higher grades.

Early Years 2 (EY2)

Age: 3.5 to 4.5 years

Early Years 2 (EY2) at TIPS is marked by aggregate reinforcement of all that was introduced in Nursery along with a formal introduction to alphabet sounds and numbers through tracing using Montessori materials and small movables. Tracing is important because children are still very sensitive to touch till about 3.5 to 4 years of age. Therefore, be it letters of the alphabet or numbers they can assimilate sensorial and muscular memory impressions. The rhymes and stories at circle time get a little more vocabulary-rich and impromptu role playing based on stories narrated are encouraged to bring about confidence and social interaction skills in children. Object talk and riddles challenge children to think about things they see in their environment. Animals and nature are explored a little more in detail. The emphasis on EPL, sensorial, open-ended material play, movement and outdoor play continues.



Early Years 3 (EY3)



Age: 4.5 to 5.5 years

Early Years 3 (EY3) at TIPS marks the phase when children can both read and write alphabet, numbers and short sentences. Social interaction skills and conversation are developed further as children get ready to leave kindergarten and enter grade 1 at TIPS main campus, at the end of the academic year. Small movables for alphabet and numbers, Montessori EPL and sensorial materials, outdoor play and gardening form a good part EY3. Circle time, rhymes, music, drama and role play develop the children's confidence, speaking skills and posture. Storytelling becomes a little more nuanced as kids can now understand the differences in story narration styles, with and without voice modulation.

Day-Care, After School Assistance & Weekend Hobby Classes @ a glance

Daycare

Age: 1 to 4 years

Age: 4 to 6 years

Our Day-Care program provides the ideal atmosphere for children to thrive in. With warm and caring staff and plenty of time to jump around and play, the child will have a home away from home.

At TIPS Day-Care, toddlers and young children can play, learn, enjoy meals and rest. There will be plenty of opportunities for the child to play and develop emotionally and physically. Here we focus on:

Physical development activities

Children can play running and catching games, hide-and-seek-games and other such games that include physical activities. This helps the child in motor skill development.

Social activities

It includes social interaction with other children, getting along with others, turn-taking, participation and cooperation.



Creative activities

Children will be made to paint, listen to stories, play music and be creative. They would enjoy free-play, in which the children can choose what they would like to do. This way, the child's creativity gets nurtured.

Reading activities

The teachers or supervisors will help the children to read and understand what is given in the books like picture books, rhyme books and story books. This helps the child to develop his/her reading skills.



After School Assistance Program*

Age: 6 to 12 years

This program provides tutoring and mentoring for kids of age 6-12 years by trained staff, to support and help the academic challenges they might face when working on the home practice work given by their regular school and or prepare for tests and examinations. This program assists kids in meeting head on challenging experiences on a daily basis

Activities include homework help and tutoring which raises students' academic proficiency, reinforces and enhances skills and knowledge learned at school, teaches students the concept of academic goal setting, other academic activities like learning Math, English, Science & Reading.

Age: 4 to 12 years
